



## 2024 Pool & Spa Service Contract

### Pool Opening Includes:

- Remove pool cover and winter plugs
- Blow off cover and deck around pool
- Reassemble pool equipment and start filtration system
- Reinstall deck equipment
- Brush walls, floor, and tile
- Heaters will be test fired but left off
- Pool cleaner will be installed (if applicable)
- If we cannot see the bottom of the pool on the day of opening, the pool will be shocked and vacuumed on the next visit.

\*\* Customer must have all heavy debris and water off the pool cover at time of opening. There will be a fee of \$130 to remove water and debris.\*\*

\*\* The water level must be to the top of the skimmers. If it is not, BRPS may not be able to start the pool or add DE to the filter. This would be done on the first cleaning.\*\*

\*\* A service agreement must be signed and returned with a submission of payment prior to the pool opening. We will not open a pool without this documentation.\*\*

### Pool Closing Includes:

- Pump out water – 3" below skimmer for solid and 12" for mesh covers
- Pool deck area blown off
- Winterize all plumbing lines
- Remove deck equipment
- Pool pump and filter disassembled, cleaned, and drained
- Install cover
- Add winter chemicals

\*\* BRPS is not responsible for providing winter plugs, cover, etc. We have plugs and water bags on the truck and will charge customer if they are needed. \*\*

\*\* BRPS will vacuum pool if closing is scheduled the week after the last cleaning service. If it is past a week, the customer will be charged \$65 per 30 minutes to vacuum to pool. \*\*

\*\* BRPS will not close a pool until account is paid in full \*\*

### Weekly/ Bi-weekly/ Monthly Service Visits Include:

- Vacuum and skim pool surface

- Brush entire pool
- Empty skimmer baskets
- Backwash and clean filters once per month
- Clean out pump basket and pool cleaner bag
- Test water chemistry and balance pool water
- Email with service report

\*\* If pool water is too dark or cloudy to see the bottom of the pool, BRPS will add chemicals to clear up the pool. A \$75 fee will be charged to come back to vacuum once the pool is clear \*\*

\*\* Any cleaning taking more than an hour will be charged an additional \$50 \*\*

\*\* Pool owner must maintain the water level in the pool \*\*

## Payment Terms and Conditions:

### Pre-pay Option

- Extended Weekly Service (Pool opening, closing, and 26 weekly visits) \$ 3795
- Weekly Service (Pool opening, closing, and 18 weekly visits) \$ 3075
- Bi-Weekly Service (Pool opening, closing, and 10 bi-weekly visits) \$ 2075
- Monthly Service (Pool opening, closing, and 4 monthly visits) \$1375

### Payment Plan

- A payment plan is available and adds \$50 to the pre-pay plan cost. 4 equal payments will be made **prior to the opening, June 30, July 30, and August 30.**

**Prices above do not include chemicals or any extra work that is done during opening, closing, or service visits.**

- Additional weekly visits are charged at \$100 per visit
- Additional bi-weekly visits are charged at \$110 per visit
- Additional monthly visits are charged at \$125 per visit

### Stipulations

- Your service plan will not start until BRPS has a valid credit card on file or pre-payment
- Chemicals are NOT included in the service plan and will be provided by BRPS each visit. They will be billed out monthly based on the bulk pricing on the chemical list.
- If you use chlorine tablets, you will be required to purchase either a 25 or 50 lb container at the beginning of the season.
- BRPS is authorized to perform minor repairs as needed up to \$50, ie skimmer basket, O rings, motor seals, minor plumbing repairs.
- Unpaid balances over 30 days will receive a late fee of 1.5% every 30 days it is not paid. Service payment plans must be paid on time. If payment is not made, service will stop immediately and resume once payment has been made.
- Any repairs needed that are over \$50 will be sent as an estimate and need to be accepted by the customer and paid before they are completed.

- Visits not used from the service contract are non-refundable.
- BRPS will not close a pool with an account that is not paid in full for the season.

### **Terms and Conditions**

- Blue River Pool Services LLC will carry all necessary general liability and workers compensation insurance as required by law
- Blue River Pool Services LLC will not be held responsible for any damage to lawns or landscaping due to the discharge of pool water
- Blue River Pool Services LLC will not assume responsibility or liability for damages incurred by removal or reinstallation of equipment or parts that are corroded, rusted, or otherwise deteriorated. Repairs and replacement will be made at the owner's expense.
- At the time of opening, Blue River Pool Services LLC is not responsible for any missing or damaged items of the pool equipment that is stored on the owner's property under the care and keeping of the owner.
